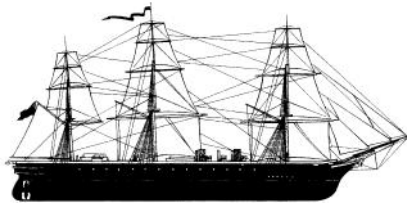

In the stokehold and engine room



The **stokehold** is the place where men shovelled coal into the furnaces to heat water for Warrior's steam engine.
